

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF YPSILANTI  
MINUTES OF THE JUNE 25, 2012 WORK SESSION**

Supervisor Stumbo stated it should be confirmed that the request fit the necessary criteria, from a legal standpoint for donating money. She asked the attorney to verify.

The Board agreed to have the three full-time administrators meet with Riverside Arts Center representatives. She said they would get more details and bring it back to the Board at the next meeting.
