Are you a homeowner age 62 years or older with an annual gross household income of \$40,000 a year or less? If so, you may qualify for a tax deferment. A deferment extends the deadline to pay property taxes until April 30 without interest or penalty. Please contact the Treasurer's Office at 734-544-4000 for more information.
