Ecorse Rd Re-design

Thank you to all of those who attended or submitted feedback to the Ecorse Rd Redesign Open House on Monday, May 4. We had a very strong turnout where there were a lot of strong, engaging conversations with a wide range of opinions on this plan. We need some time to review these further.

The plan we shared at the Open House was developed based on resident input from 2018 and reinforced through the community's Master Plan process in 2020. Based on this recent feedback, we will work with consultants to determine what the next steps are for this project. We will keep the public aware of these steps including any future input opportunities. Your feedback is appreciated and valuable to the Township in consideration for this corridor.
