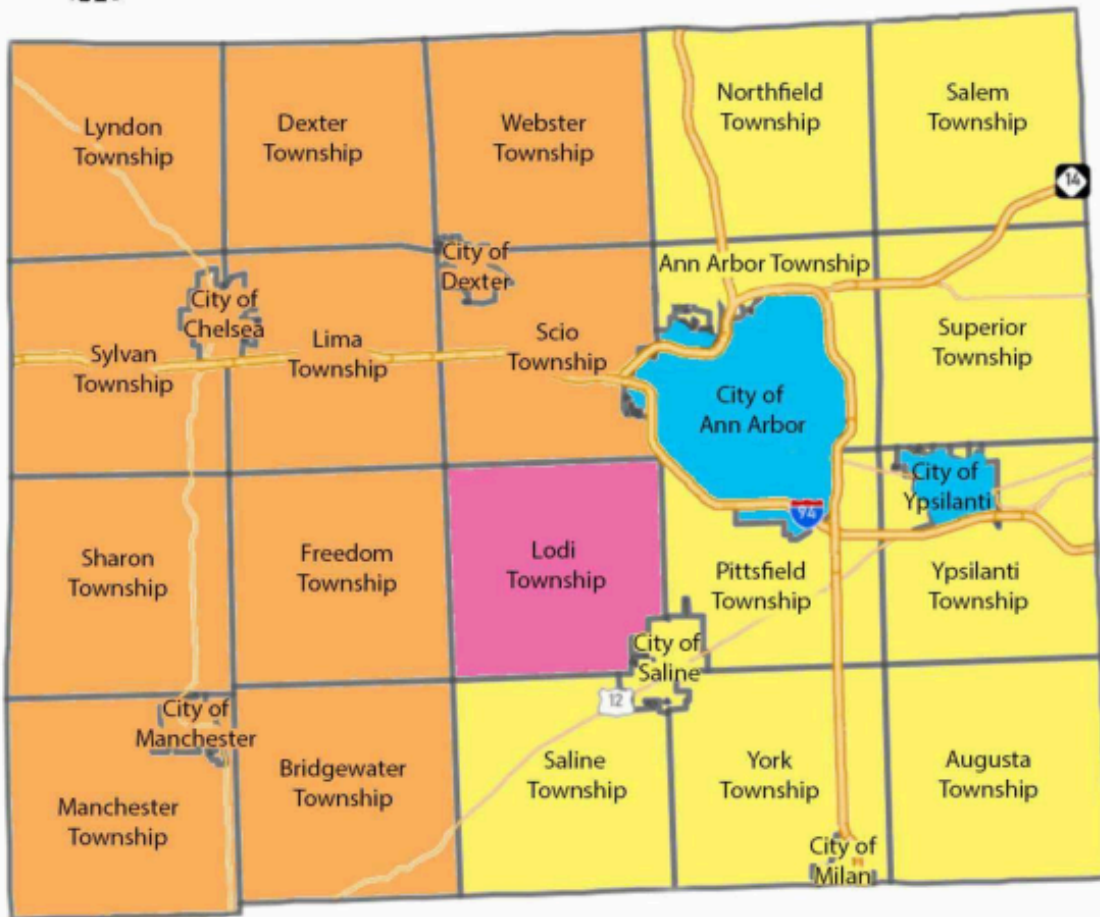
They are closed to the public in January and February .
