VI. HOMEOWNER AFFIDAVIT

I hereby certify the electrical work described on this permit application shall be installed **by myself, in my own home**, which I am living in or am about to occupy. All work shall be installed in accordance with the Electrical Code and **shall not be enclosed, covered up or put into operation** until it has been **inspected and approved** by the Electrical Inspector. I will cooperate with the Electrical Inspector and assume the responsibility to arrange for necessary inspections and also understand that performing construction activities in contradiction to the application language is a violation of STATE law - Public Act 299; Article 24, section 339.2403.

GENERAL: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for inspection, call the building department at (734) 485.3943. A minimum of one business day advance notice required. The clerk will need the JOB LOCATION AND PERMIT NUMBER.	Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work has not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work.

A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELED PERMITS MAY NOT HAVE A 60% REFUND IF INSPECTIONS / SITE VISITS HAVE BEEN MADE OR SIX MONTHS TIME HAS ELAPSED SINCE PERMIT ISSUANCE. PLAN REVIEW FEES ARE **NOT REFUNDABLE.**
