GENERAL: Work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for inspection, call the building department at (734) 544-4000. A minimum of one business day advance notice is required. The clerk will need the JOB LOCATION AND PERMIT NUMBER.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing, and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work has not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work

A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELED PERMITS MAY NOT HAVE A 60% REFUND IF INSPECTIONS / SITE VISITS HAVE BEEN MADE OR SIX MONTHS TIME HAS ELASPED SINCE PERMIT ISSUANCE. PLAN REVIEW FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE.
