### Modern Day Martial Arts

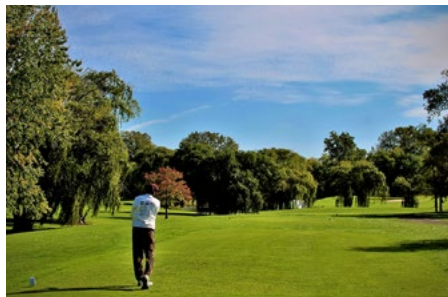

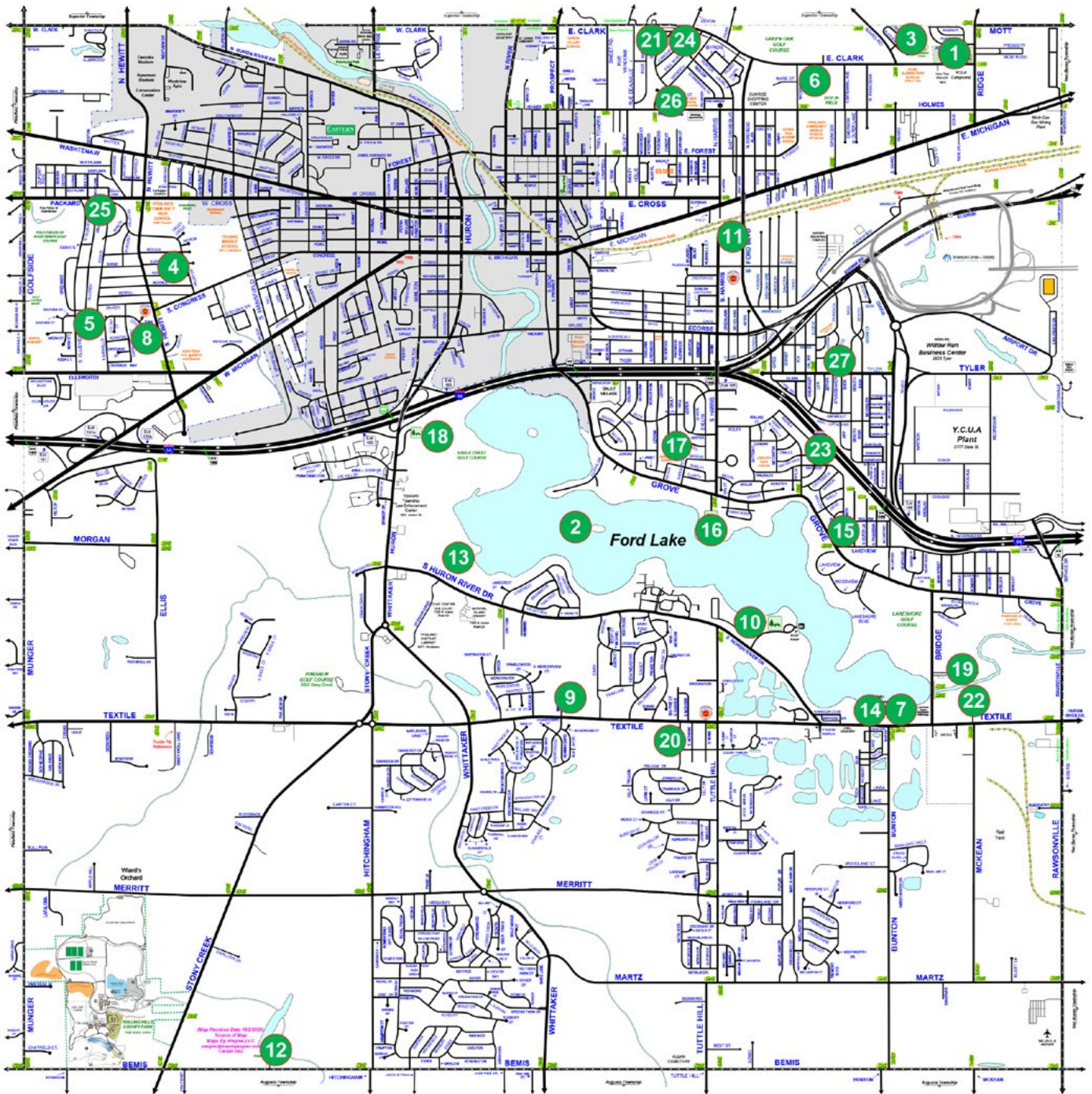
