MEMORANDUM

RE: Special Board Meeting Request

Last week, we discovered that the Township has an opportunity to be able to bid on some equipment from the city of Ann Arbor, including a Scarab windrow turner and a dump truck, through a government run website. Unfortunately, the bidding expires on Monday afternoon, just hours before our next scheduled board meeting.

This equipment is of such a nature and price that I feel it would be of the utmost best interest of the Township to grant me permission to bid on these 2 items.

The equipment we are interested in bidding on is a Scarab Windrow Turner that would be used at the Compost Site to turn all of our windrows of compost material. We have obtained a quote on this piece of equipment as new and it would cost \$474,000. The minimum bid for this 2004 is \$30,000 and so far there are no bidders. We feel this equipment may be worth up to \$100,000 and that may be what the unit ultimately sells for. This equipment would not only help save lots of time for our operator out there turning our material, it would also allow us to fit more material on each of our pads.

The other equipment is actually a heavy duty dump truck that the city used to plow their streets. It is a 1997 that has only 67,000 miles on it and it has a low bid so far set at \$5,050. This vehicle would have a multi-purpose for us. Including during the season we could use it to pull our chipper for resident chipping and it would be useful out at the Compost Site as well for hauling material. It has a 15 yard dump on the back and a belly plow so that we would be able to grade our own gravel drives and parking lots in our Parks. In looking at comparable vehicles on a trade magazine, we are seeing these trucks with 500,000 miles on it selling for over \$5,000. We feel the value of this truck is at least \$15,000.

On Friday, March 2, both Carl Rowsey and I visited the Ann Arbor yard and viewed and started/ran each of these units. Both of us were very impressed with their condition.

I will bring photos and more information to the meeting on both of these requests.

It would recommend that we use the Environmental Services fund balance for this purchase. We ended 2011 with a balance in the 226 account of \$3,418,627.


