MCImetro Access Transmission Services Corp. d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services requests the Township grant it a Bilateral Permit under the METRO Act. Verizon Access Transmission Services is seeking use of the public right-of-way to install fiber-optic facilities, as described further below.

Enclosed are three (3) copies of the application along with a check for \$500 to cover the application fee. The METRO Act states that "A municipality shall approve or deny access under this section within 45 days from the date a provider files an application for a permit for access to a public right-of-way." MCL 484.3115(3).

Below is more background on Verizon Access Transmission Service's planned fiber project:

- Fiber will be deployed to provide wireline, fiber-based high speed telecommunications services to existing and new small, medium and large business (enterprise) customers.
- The fiber facilities will not be used to offer wireline residential services such as home phone or cable television services.
- Fiber-optic cable will be installed within the right-of-way (underground within conduit or aerial on poles).
- In addition to installing fiber for small, medium, and large business customers, Verizon Access Transmission Services will also deploy fiber to wireless facilities.
- Verizon Access Transmission Services does not seek permission through this Metro Act Permit Application to construct or install wireless facilities. Verizon Wireless may separately seek approval in conformance with applicable law to site wireless facilities.

The route map of the proposed facilities required in Section 2.3 of the application is shown in Exhibit 1. Final design of the facilities has not been completed, thus the route map is high level and subject to

change. Specific design details (e.g., aerial vs. buried, which side of the street, linear footage) will be provided during the construction permit stage.



OPINION AND ORDER

On March 21, 1997, McImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc., (MCI) filed an application to expand its license to provide basic local exchange service, pursuant to the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; MSA 22.1469(101) et seq. MCI proposes to provide service to customers in all Michigan exchanges currently served by Ameritech Michigan and GTE North Incorporated (GTE), including those exchanges that GTE proposed to transfer to PTI Communications of Michigan, Inc.

On March 24, 1997, the Commission directed MCI to publish a notice of opportunity to comment in newspapers of general circulation in MCI's proposed service area. The Commis-

sion Staff was the only party to file comments. It noted a concern, but does not oppose the granting of the application.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended by 1995 PA 216, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; MSA 22.1469(101) et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101) et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACS, R 460.17101 et seq.
 - b. Amending MCI's license to provide basic local exchange service is in the public interest.
- c. MCI should continue to be bound by the regulatory requirements for basic local exchange service set forth in the Commission's March 29, 1995 order in Case No. U-10610.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- A. The license of MCImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc., to provide basic local exchange service is amended to include all Michigan exchanges currently served by Ameritech Michigan and GTE North Incorporated.
- B. McImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc., shall continue to be bound by the regulatory requirements for basic local exchange service set forth in the Commission's order in Case No. U-10610.
- C. Before commencing service, MCImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc., shall submit its tariff to reflect the scope of the services that it will offer.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary,



Thank you for the opportunity to submit this proposal to provide professional architecture services for the Township. As you know, the Township has a Capital Improvement Plan in place for the various improvements needed for Township infrastructure. In this proposal, we have outlined the scope and clarifications necessary to seek bids for the Township to address the roof replacement.

PROJECT UNDERSTANDING

The project consists of replacing roofs at both the Civic Center, located at 7200 S. Huron River Drive, as well as the Community Center, located at 2025 E. Clark Road. Two (2) sections of EPDM (rubber) roofs, Sections B & C/C2, are in need of replacement at the Civic Center and two (2) sections of shingled roof, Sections B & D, at the Community Center. POVERTY EXEMPTION GUIDELINES

WHEREAS, the homestead of persons who, in the judgment of the Supervisor and Board of Review, by reason of poverty, are unable to contribute to the public charges is eligible for exemption in whole or part from taxation under Section 7u of the Michigan Property Tax Act, Public Act 206 of 1893; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 211.7u, Ypsilanti Charter Township, Washtenaw County adopts the following guidelines for the Supervisor and Board of Review to implement. The guidelines shall include but not be limited to the specific income and asset levels of the claimant and all persons residing in the household, including any property tax credit returns filed in the current or immediately preceding year;

To be eligible, a person shall do all the following on an annual basis:

- 1) Be an owner and occupy as a homestead (primary residence) the property for which an exemption is requested.
- File a claim with the Supervisor or board of Review, accompanied by federal and state income tax returns for all persons residing in the homestead, including property tax credit returns, filed in the current or immediately preceding year.
- 3) Meet the income threshold guidelines (maximum income) adopted by the Township Board. The income threshold as adopted is that all household income cannot exceed 30% of the median income for Ann Arbor (Washtenaw County) as published by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) as of December 31 of the preceding year. These income thresholds will be used as long as they are higher than the Federal Poverty Guidelines as determined annually by the United States Office of Management and Budget.
- 4) Meet the maximum asset eligibility test as follows: Assets other than the taxpayer's primary residence and usual household goods valued at more than 50% of all annual household income will be considered and added to the household income to determine eligibility.
- 5) The revised Taxable Value with the Poverty Exemption, subject to the above guidelines, shall be the lesser of the current taxable value on the assessment roll and the following formula calculating the minimum taxable value via the Poverty Exemption Guidelines.
 - (State of Michigan Homestead Tax Credit (MI 1040CR) + 3.5% of Income) / Current Millage Rate = Minimum Taxable Value

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Review shall follow the above stated policy and guidelines in granting or denying exemptions. If the Board of Review determines there are substantial and compelling reasons why there should be a deviation from the above policy and guidelines based upon extraordinary circumstances and these are documented in writing, then the Board of Review may deviate from the above guidelines.

The American Center for Mobility (ACM) is constructing a new water main to be installed within Washtenaw County road right-of-way along the south side of Airport Road near Kirk Profit Drive as part of its testing center campus and future technology park development. A construction easement is necessary because the construction area encroaches on property at 2935 Airport Road owned by Ypsilanti Township.

The Washtenaw County Road Commission has granted a right-Of-way construction permit, and the Ypsilanti Community Utilities Authority has approved the design and construction of the water main. The removal of an existing fence, trees, shrubs and vegetation and restoration there-of at the property will be completed at the expense of ACM.

A proposed construction easement agreement prepared by ACM engineers and reviewed by Township legal counsel is enclosed. I respectfully request that the Board of Trustees approve the easement agreement and authorize signatures for full execution of the agreement.
