#### **Projects:**

**Concrete Repairs- Delayed**, approved by the Board to go out to bid. Construction was planned for summer 2023, however the cost came in doubled and the project is on hold until funding is available. Planning on submitting for the 2026 budget.

**Sluice Gate Stress Analysis- 2024,** the FERC has requested a detailed study of the spillway gates. This is a common industry request from FERC as they continuously look at safety involving dams. The inspections were completed, and the engineer has identified some items for consideration. This will need to be part of the budgeting process.

#### **River Level Sensor**

Premature failure of this sensor has caused negative impact to the operation and emergency actions. Staff are working with engineers to fix the problem. In February, a radar style sensor was installed in parallel to the existing system. This new technology seems promising to help reduce the on-going cost and better system reliability. The testing period for the new sensor was planned for 60 days, this has been extended due to a defect in the sensor.

**DTE/ITC Power Line Rebuild**- ITC is planning a rebuild of the transmission line along Bridge Road. Project is planned in 2026 will likely take a couple of months to complete. We don't know how this will impact Hydro's operations.

**DTE Gas Line relocation**- DTE has submitted plans to relocate the gas line attached to the bridge and dam. The project has easements now through North and South Hydro Parks. Construction will commence when the dams' concrete work is under contract.

#### **MOU** with City of Ann Arbor

The Parties share a common interest in eliminating and preventing nuisance blue green algae blooms in Ford and Belleville Lakes, and they acknowledge that information about water quality and conditions in the lakes is important to advancing their common interest. THEREFORE, the Parties enter into this Memorandum of Understanding to memorialize their understanding as to their efforts to cooperate and work together to monitor, collect, and share water quality information regarding Ford and Belleville Lakes.

#### Work Plan

- for 2025, continue collecting data, follow updated discharge plan Current Activities
  - WQ equipment was deployed in May, some earlier issues have been resolved.

#### **Sluice Gate Usage Summary**

Releasing water from the sluice gates is primary done to maintain lake level when flow exceeds the powerhouse. At certain times, we can use the gates to help keep the lake mixed to maintain oxygen levels (effectiveness depends on several factors) at the bottom of the lake.

The water quality monitoring begins on June 1<sup>st</sup> and will end on September 30<sup>th</sup>; operators monitor the water quality conditions and take readings as outlined in the WQ Plan. The dam releases water from the bottom gates to maintain run of river and/or help with the water quality in Ford Lake. The Federal License requires us to pass water with a minimum of 5mg/l of dissolved oxygen all the time. Therefore, spilling from the bottom gates in the summer to improve the lake is not always possible.

The Office of Community Standards (OCS) encompasses the Building, Ordinance and Planning Departments. Ordinance consists of a Director, Ordinance Administrator and five (5) full-time Ordinance Officers. Additionally, to support both Building and Ordinance there is an Executive Coordinator and three (3) administrative Clerks.

The Ordinance Department performs rental inspections on approximately 8,000 multi-family apartments in 77 complexes and 4,100 single-family homes, on a two-year cycle. Additionally, Ordinance investigates ordinance violation complaints, inspects vacant structures, performs liquor inspections, junkyard inspections and monitors buildings that have sustained fire damage.

Here is a summary of Ordinance Department activity conducted in September 2025:

**Ordinance Investigations** – There were a total of **572** inspections conducted, including **231** for vegetation violations (tall grass/weeds and branches/brush) and **54** parking complaints (lawn/street). In addition to our most frequent violations of tall grass/weeds and parking issues, Ordinance also investigated complaints regarding:

- Vacant, Dilapidated or Abandoned Buildings
- Zoning Issues Fences, Signs, Accessory Structures, Etc.
- Sidewalk Obstructions
- Accumulated Trash/Rubbish
- Blight/Graffiti
- Non-Operating Motor Vehicles
- Illegal/Nuisance Business
- Construction Without Permits

**Rental Inspections** – A total of **411** rental inspections were conducted by Ordinance Officers. This includes **79** single-family rental homes, **332** multi-family apartments, initial and reinspections. In September we also began a comprehensive program to inspect rental units in the seven (7) mobile home parks in the Township.

**Vacant Structures** – There are currently **261** vacant structures that have been inspected and certified by Ordinance. On an annual basis each vacant structure has an internal and external inspection prior to being certified. This month a total of **12** inspections were performed.

**Liquor Inspections** – There were **9** inspections conducted at businesses licensed to sell liquor to ensure they are complying with state and local liquor laws.

**Fire Damaged Property** – There were **12** inspections performed to monitor the status of structures that have sustained fire damage. Ordinance monitors the removal of any blight caused by the fire and continues to monitor the repair/demolition progress until the property is restored.

**Administrative Search Warrants** – There was **1** ASW issued by 14B District Court to gain access to inspect a house, in a situation where we have been unable to perform a routine inspection, with the goal of identifying violations that could impact public safety, property values and neighboring properties.

**District Court Hearings** – There were **18** formal and informal hearings attended at 14B District Court for citations issued for failure to correct violations identified.

**Circuit Court Litigation** – We have **31** current active litigation cases in Washtenaw County Circuit Court.






## Network Performance Considerations

- The Acceptable Alternative without diversion is expected to experience a total of 673 hours of delay, with 437 hours expected during the PM peak alone
- Assuming a **15% diversion and mode shift** along the entirety of the corridor **reduces** the expected daily delay **by 329 hours** or 49%.
- The No Build/Existing Conditions Option currently experiences a delay of 400 hours
- The large decrease in delay can be attributed to operational improvements at key intersections as well as reduction in delay at all other intersections along the corridor.





Subject: Reopening Civic Center during the lunch hour

The current hours of operation for the Township Civic Center are Monday – Friday, 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. In October of 2010, the Board of Trustees voted to close the building during the lunch hour from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m., primarily due to reduced office staffing, reducing hours for staff to 32 hours and not filling vacant positions in response to the loss of General Motors Plant and the housing foreclosure that hit our community with devastation.

When we closed, we explained to the community that we were closing for lunch primarily due to the inability to adequately staff the departments.

We have witnessed many residents who have tried to conduct business to pay their tax bill, voting, building permits, information from ordinance etc. Township staffing has been restored during the last year, and it is time to ask that the restoration of our building be open 8:30-4:30 for our residents be restored. In the past this was managed by staggering lunch hours, so the building can remain open during 12:00 p.m. – 1:00 p.m.

Returning to being open during lunch would not change the starting or ending work hours for any employees, and they would continue receiving their hourly paid lunch.

Your consideration for approval of this request for the public is appreciated. We will work as a Township Team to make sure covering of offices occurs. We have notified the respective unions of this request, and it does not violate union contracts. We would like to implement this effective January 2026 when employees return from the Holiday break.

This also gives the township and court time to get used to the new schedule.

As part of the requirements set by Michigan Tax Law (MCL 211.10e) and the State Tax Commission Land Value Map Publications, Ypsilanti Township is required to maintain both tax and land value maps. Further, the current Township's GIS mapping system has become a vital tool that is utilized by both the Assessment and Planning Departments. The GIS also supports many other Township Departments and Township Residents. The Township's GIS data is published by Washtenaw County on their online public website at <a href="https://www.washtenaw.org">www.washtenaw.org</a>.

Ypsilanti Township currently uses ESRI's ArcMap 10.8.2. After March 2026, ESRI will no longer support this version of the software. Therefore, the Township is required to upgrade the GIS Software from ArcMap 10.8.2 to ArcGIS Pro 3.4.3. This software upgrade will require the Township GIS Data to be migrated to the new software, which would require the creation of a new parcel fabric for the approximately 18,000 parcels within Ypsilanti Township.

Our goal is to contract with a GIS Consultant for the data migration, the creation of a parcel fabric, and other requirements as described within Section 4.2 of the attached Request for Proposals. The Township is also looking for a contractor that once the GIS Data is migrated to the new software, will conduct regular maintenance on the data as required, to include new parcel splits and edits to the data on a per job or yearly term basis.

### **OBJECTIVE AND BACKGROUND**

### 1.1 Objectives of this Request for Proposal

The Ypsilanti Township ("**Township**") is soliciting proposals in response to this Request for Proposal ("**RFP**") from contractors, hereafter referred to collectively as "**Proposers**," to provide **GIS CONSULTING SERVICES** as more particularly described in Section 4 (Scope of Work) of this RFP.

### 1.2 Description of Township

The Charter Township of Ypsilanti, Michigan is located east of Ann Arbor and west of Detroit along the I-94 corridor. Ypsilanti Township serves a population of approximately 58,000. Ypsilanti Township provides a full range of services, including fire protection, court services, recreational facilities and programming, golf and sold waste services. The Township's operational commitment is to provide reliable and excellent service to citizens at competitive prices and to guide responsible stewardship of Township resources.

### 1.3 **Project Background**

Ypsilanti Township has owned and maintained it's own GIS Data for more than 30 years. The Township currently utilizes ESRI's ArcMap 10.8.2 software to maintain the GIS Data, administer parcel divisions and to make any map edits, performed by the Assessment Department. The GIS Data is then shared with Washtenaw County who publishes the data to their public online GIS Mapping program located at <a href="https://www.washtenaw.org">www.washtenaw.org</a>. The Assessment and Planning Departments create GIS maps utilized by the Township for Assessment Administration and Planning and Zoning purposes, MCL 211.10e required Tax and Land Value Maps.

As ArcMap 10.8.2 will no longer be supported by ESRI as of the end of March 2026, the Township will be required to migrate their GIS Data to the ArcGIS Pro 3.4.3 software, convert the existing GIS data to the new format and create a parcel fabric.

### 1.4 Terms of Agreement

If the Township enters into an Agreement as a result of this RFP, The Township anticipates the initial term of the Agreement will be for one (1) year ("Initial Term"), with the option, at the Township's discretion, to extend the Contractor's Services for two (2) additional terms of one (1) year each (each an "Extension Term"). The Initial Term and each Extension Term are collectively referred to as the "Term".
