Loonfeather Park very close to being done – should be completed this week or next. Finish date of June 24.

Huron St. trail (west side of Huron Rd.) now under construction, almost done (the only tasks left south of Joe Hall Dr are concrete curing at post office and the church.)

North Bay Park needed electrical work on short notice. AF Smith contracted for the job.

Apple Ridge Park/Willow Run Acres community farm agreement finalized. DTE running a power line to power the irrigation well.

Township leadership and board will make a formal appointment to fill empty park board position created when Brad O'Conner moved out of state. Status of applications is unknown.

Suggestion was made that perhaps it would be better to wait until early fall when things are slower and staff have more flexible schedules.

Discussion of Park Hours: current wording is "15 minutes after sunset" but causes confusion among park users. Robin proposed set specific times. Commissioner Hodge looked up sunset times. Mike Hoffmeister suggested setting summer close at 9 pm now for safety reasons then discuss additional winter times later.

Motion to change park closing of parks for summer hours to 9 pm Motion made by Neel Seconded by Kirby Passed unanimously

Request Approval to allow US Geological Survey to conduct Phragmites, a tall invasive weed, research at North Hydro Park.

Kirk Kowalski, Research Ecologists, spoke. He's a Wetlands research scientist, studying the invasive species Phragmites. There is a need to find a way to manage the plant, as it is a problem throughout N. America. Looking for management solution and partnering with Rutgers University. Currently working in Oakland County and in Sandusky MI, and would like to work at Hydro Park. Needs: access to site 2x - 3x week. Will apply non-toxic fungicide to see if it successfully controls plant.

Discussion: Hodge asked about herbicide license and training.

Allow research pending herbicide applicator license/training is necessary

Motion to approve the study, pending approval by the MI Dept. of Agriculture and Rural Development.

Motion made by Kirby.

Seconded by Neel.

Passed unanimously.
