Akin Oluwadare represents Odini Youth Action Village Storytelling Group from West Willow neighborhood. Want to ensure that West Willow Park is more accessible and have equitable resources devoted to park.

Tavon: neighborhood group tries to maintain park on own: painting over graffiti and installing chain basketball nets.

Hessir (sp?): lives in neighborhood. Safe space for area youth but is falling apart. Mike Hoffmeister: 1) requested that more resources devoted to this park. 2) invited attendees to be part of Master Plan process. Commissioner Burnett mentioned Skate Park process initiated by youth group. Commissioner Streeter thanked group for submitting videos of issues/problems to be fixed.

Linda Neeley: would like to see the park maintained, need a safe place for youth to play.

Karen Wilson: reports of broken glass in the park. Need Rules posted.

Akin: meet every other Friday from 6 - 7:30 at the Community Center.

Mike Hoffmeister, Residential Service Director

- Huron St. Trail: both southbound lanes are open. Eastbound ramp now open.
- Loonfeather Park Update: awaiting handrail ADA approval but is otherwise done.
- Masterplan bids opened last week. Received 5 bids; will request they come in for presentation.
- The Clubview Park and Community Center Parks tennis renovation: Need deed to show ownership of park deed and title support (MDNR requirement) for grant approvals for tennis courts renovations.
- North Hydro, Ford Lake and Ford Heritage remain open in winter.

John Hines, Recreation Services Manager

VIII. Unfinished Business

USGS report on North Hydro Spencer Widin, biologist, and Kurt Kowalski, Research Ecologist. Update on phragmites (common reed) microbial control experiment. Invasive species and very challenging to control plant. 30 plots: 10 were treated with water only, 10 treated every 2 weeks, 10 treated every 4 weeks. Results: 2-week treatment shows best results: kills above ground but limited underground. Hope to return in spring to observe regrowth.

Park Hours discussion (continuation): opening and closing hours for staffed parks. Summer hours (Memorial Day to Labor Day) closing at 9 pm. Winter hours proposed for 6 pm.

Motion to set hours for gated parks – Ford Lake, Ford Heritage, North Hydro, Loonfeather, North Bay, Lakeside, Hewen's Creek – for 9 pm summer (Memorial Day until Labor Day) and 6 pm for other times (winter) made by Hine. Seconded by Kirby Motion Carried Unanimously (Streeter abstained.)

Discussion: Mike Hoffmeister indicated that recommendation will be sent to Board of Trustees, will need to have two hearings and discussion. If passes Board, then will move to implementing such things as signage.

Motion for 10 minute recess due to citizen health emergency made by Streeter. Seconded by Burnett. Passed unanimously.
