Spencer Widon, US Geological Survey: Phragmites Research Update. USGS has been running experiments for 2 years at North Hydro Park, applying organic (vs chemical) treatments. In the second year of the experiment, they set up 40 additional plots and varied techniques and timing of application of the herbicide. Promising results - much less growth of the invasive species in treated ai eas. Rhizomes ai e large difficult to eradicate but treatments reduce carbohydrate storage by 50%. Hope a third year will help fmiher advance experimental results. Asking for approval for a third year.

Streeter- has formulation changed? Widin - added more surfactant to help spread the herbicide but active ingredients are the same.
