

GET HELP WITH YOUR EVICTION

Rental and Legal Help for Tenants in Washtenaw County

Go to ALL court hearings (especially your first one)

- If you miss ANY of your hearings, the court may take a "default judgment" against you, leading to your eviction and making it harder to rent other places in the future.
- The hearing instructions can be found on the "Summons."
- You can attend court:
 - through Zoom by phone or video, or
 - in-person at the court
- If you have questions about going to your hearing, call the court.

*Find the court phone number listed near the top right side of the Summons.
