STATE PROPOSAL:

Proposal 2026-01

A Proposal to Convene a Constitutional Convention for the Purpose of Drafting a General Revision of the State Constitution. Shall a convention of elected delegates be convened in 2027 to draft a general revision of the State Constitution for presentation to the state's voters for their approval or rejection.

Proposal 2026-02

A Proposed Initiated Law to prohibit Campaign Contribution from Certain Regulated Utilities and Government Contractors and Apply Campaign Finance Laws and Regulations to Additional Types of Political Communications.

Absent Voter ballots are available for all elections. Any registered voter may obtain an application for an Absent Voter Ballot at the Ypsilanti Township Clerk's office or online at Michigan Voter Information Center at Michigan.gov/vote. Voters with disabilities may request an accessible absent voter ballot, they are available online.

The deadline to receive an Absentee Ballot is **Monday November 2nd by 4:00pm** at the Clerk's Office.

Early Voting in Person: Saturday October 24-Sunday November 1, 8:00am-4:00pm except Tuesday October 27 and Thursday October 29, 11:00-7:00pm at Civic Center 7200 S. Huron River Dr and Community Center on 2025 E. Clark Road.

Register to vote online at Michigan.gov/vote until Monday October 19, 2026, or in person at the Ypsilanti Township Clerk's Office, 7200 S. Huron River Drive until 8:00p.m. on Election Day with proof of residency.

All polling locations are accessible to voters with disabilities. The voter assist terminal, Braille and audio instruction are also available in all polling locations. Absentee ballots are available for all elections; registered voters may contact the local clerk to obtain an application for an absent voter ballot.
