Dear DTE Customer:

To keep your natural gas service safe and reliable, we are upgrading our natural gas equipment in your area. Timing of this vital work has been coordinated ahead of planned road construction in the Ford Lake Dam and Textile/Bridge Roads area of Ypsilanti Township.

This natural gas work is not related to any other development projects planned in the area. Here is an overview of our plans and what you can expect:

- Gas infrastructure construction began during May 2026 and will last about seven months for the project area.
- Upgrades will include replacement of all gas main (pipes) that run from just north of the Ford Lake Dam to the intersection of Bridge and Textile roads.
- New pipes – made of more efficient and durable materials – will be installed underground. We will also be relocating the pipelines currently on Ford Lake Dam itself.

There may be some traffic detours during various phases of the work, but area businesses, industry and recreation will remain open and accessible.

We know that construction near your home, business or place of work can be inconvenient, and thank you for your cooperation while we work to keep your natural gas delivery safe and reliable.
